

BVH 10 Mile Race Day Information

Sunday September 28th 2025 9.30am

Race HQ

Banningham & Colby Hall, Banningham Village. The Sat Nav postcode is NR11 7DY. What3Words are share.waltzes.risk

Start Time

09.30am Sharp.

Please arrive at the start by 09.25am and follow marshal's guidance.

Car Parking

The best directions to the car park are along the A140, turn right if coming from Aylsham and left if coming from the Cromer direction into Banningham Road. The car park is the first field on the left. What3Words are tend.unframed.sweated or See attached map.

It is an 800m walk to the village hall so allow enough time for number collection etc.

Please do not park at the Village Hall, The Banningham Crown pub car park or around the village green.

Race numbers

Collect Race numbers on the day from Race HQ. Number collection will **open at 8am and close at 9.15am**. Your number must be attached to the front of your top. You must not cut, fold or mutilate your race number in any way. Please add any medical details and an emergency contact to the reverse of your number. Once you have collected your number please move to the main hall and do not leave any belongings in the number collection room as this will be locked once the race has started.

IMPORTANT

Race numbers must not be transferred or sold to another runner

The race has a cut off time of 2 hours

The race takes place on open public roads. Please keep left at all times and follow the marshal's instructions

Headphones Policy: -

Headphones of any kind (including bone conducting) are **NOT** permitted. The race is run on open roads and not closed to traffic. It is imperative that you can hear traffic and marshal instructions.

If you are seen wearing a device with headphones or earbuds during the race then you will be disqualified.

Facilities

There are toilets but no changing facilities so come ready to run. Baggage may be left in the village hall but this is entirely at your own risk. Or possibly a baggage drop. To be confirmed on the day. The water stations on the course are at approx. 3.5 miles & 7 miles and at the finish.

The Banningham Bowls club will be providing Tea, coffees, cakes and other goodies.

Sportlink, as sponsors of the Grand Prix races, will have a stand which will be positioned just outside the village hall.

Afterwards

The presentation of prizes will be made in the village hall at approx 12 noon.
